

RATINGS 10-24-15

Welcome to the first edition of By the Numbers for 2015! This is a rating system that uses wins, losses, points for, points against and schedule (and nothing else) to rank college football teams. A more thorough description of the system can be found on my website at www.roanoke.edu/mcsp/minton/bynumbers.html. In spite of the numerous factors missing from the system, it has averaged 74% winners and 54% against the spread. While this system provides some insights into the inner workings of the ex-BCS computers, since we now have a playoff decided by a blue-ribbon panel of college football experts the more relevant usage of these numbers is probably in handicapping future games and arguing about who really belongs in the top four.

I have some reservations about publishing this issue. There's superstition. I ran the system the last two weeks to see what was what, and the previous two number 1's both lost. (Can you name them? Last week's choice was reasonable: an unbeaten top five team. The previous week was not reasonable: a team that had already lost once - to last week's #1 - and was not in anybody else's top ten.) Plus, it feels odd to have *my team* at the top, like I'm asking for the sports gods to smack me down.

There's also instability. Usually after this many games have been played, the ratings have settled down and match the official rankings reasonably well. This year there is a strong disagreement between the two versions of my system, and everything is volatile.

And that's a big reason why I decided to write something up this week. I've been reading a book about how to make accurate predictions (*Superforecasting* by Tetlock and Gardner). The book stresses the need for multiple viewpoints – a generalized “wisdom of the crowd” idea. I run my system based on average margin of victory only and then separately on wins only (treating each game as a 20-point victory) and combine the two. The top five based on points is Clemson, Oklahoma, Baylor, Notre Dame, and Southern Cal. The top five based on wins is Iowa, LSU, Michigan State, Clemson, Notre Dame. The wins version comes closer to passing the eye test, but last week the points version beat the spread 60% of the time (the overall version 48%). So the points version looks wrong but performs well. The question is which I'm more interested in, looking good or making accurate predictions. I'm choosing the accurate predictions, but I'd rather not get a lot of grief over how “wrong” the rankings look.

The table shows different quantities. The overall rating uses schedule, net points and net wins. The “wins” column is based solely on schedule and wins-losses. The “offense” rating indicates how many points that team would score against an “average” Division 1 defense. The “defense” rating shows how many fewer points the average offense would score against this team compared to playing an average defense.

If you are curious, the top five rated offenses are Baylor (got that one right), TCU, Oklahoma, Clemson, and Texas Tech (4 of 5 from the Big 12). On defense, the top five are Michigan, Alabama, Wisconsin, Clemson, and Ohio State.

Now for some predictions. The basic prediction is to take the difference in the overall ratings, after adding 4 points to the home team. This week, Miami is a huge underdog to Duke (never thought I'd type that sentence), with Miami rated at 87.0 and Duke 97.1. The game is in Durham so we pick Duke to win by $97.1 - 87.0 + 4 = 14$ points. We can also predict the score. Take Duke's offensive rating of 40.5 and subtract Miami's defensive rating of 9.6 and we predict Duke to score 31 points. Miami's offensive rating of 35.0 minus Duke's defensive rating of 16.5 gives Miami 18 points. One problem: a score of 31-18 gives Duke a 13-point win, instead of our predicted 14-point victory. Take away 1 from Miami to make the final score 31-17 Duke. In some games, the overall prediction is for one team to win (Pittsburgh over North Carolina by 3) but the raw score prediction (which is based on the points ratings) has the other team winning (UNC, 28-23). I go with the overall prediction below.

This week does not have many blockbusters, unless you're into Louisiana (Monroe versus Lafayette) or Florida (Atlantic versus International) mid-majors. Notre Dame at Temple is the best of the week (that would be unbeaten Temple, by the way). A side note: one of last week's predictions was Missouri 5, Vanderbilt 4. The program doesn't know that 5 and 4 are unlikely scores, but it did accurately identify two bad offenses. Vanderbilt won, 10-3.

Pittsburgh 27, North Carolina 24

Stanford 38, Washington State 27

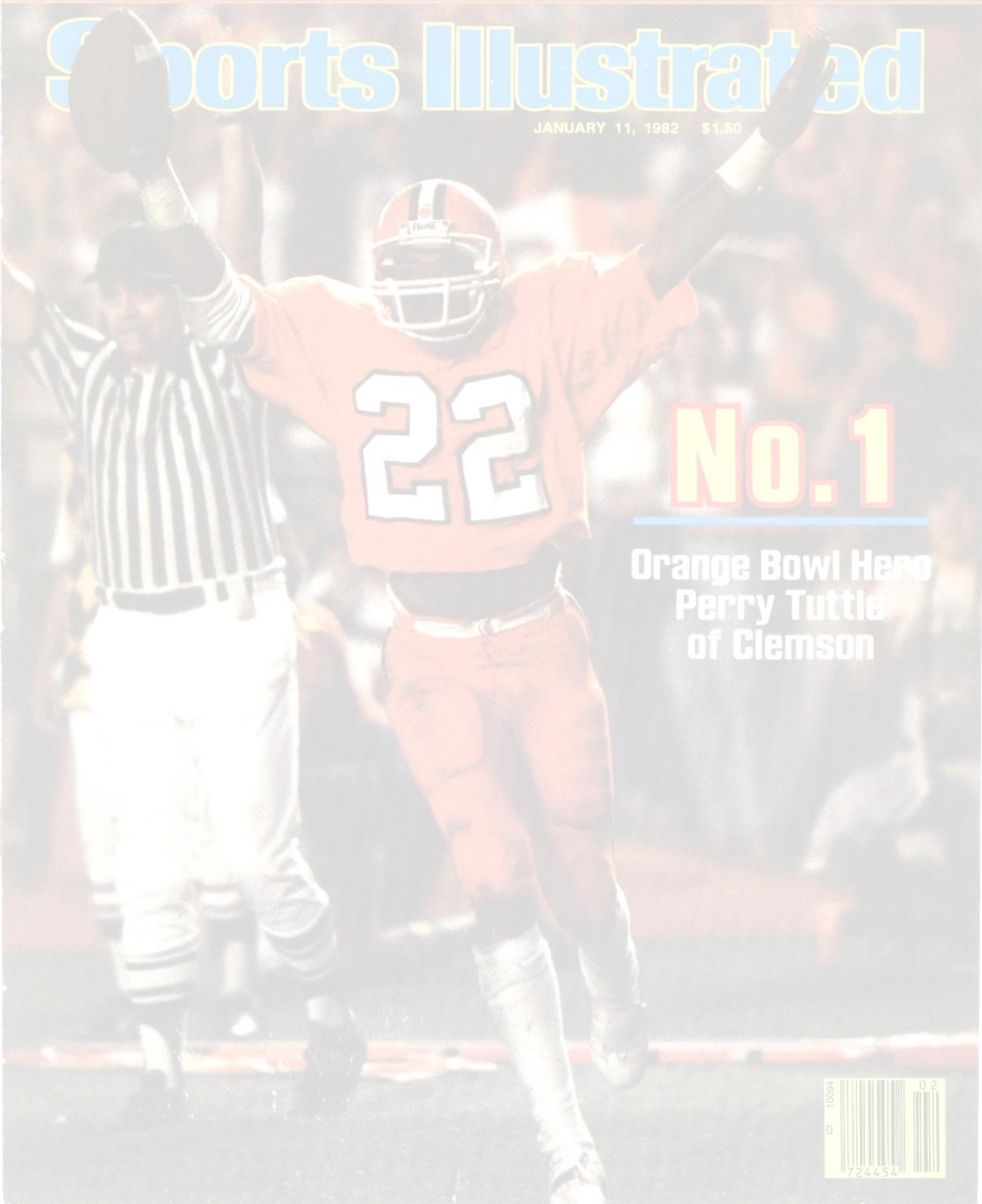
